To whom it may concern,

We are residents, traders, initiatives, associations, and collectives from the Wrangelkiez neighbourhood in Kreuzberg, and we are contacting you with an urgent request:

# We have discovered that, in the past two years, the social problems in and around Görlitzer Park and Wrangelkiez have intensified, and as residents we have been confronted with the following:

- An increase in drug use in the neighbourhood, particularly a noticeable increase in the use of hard drugs in public spaces (heroin, crystal meth, and a makred increase in crack use over the past year, according to addiction support specialists)
- An increase in drug use in stairwells, house entrances, playgrounds, gardens, etc.
- Drug paraphernalia and residue (excrement, syringes, etc.) in public spaces and building entrances
- Associated social impoverishment: homeless and poverty-stricken people in the neighbourhood, some with considerable psychological difficulties

### What is missing:

- Sufficient, adequate, decentralised offers of help for consumers, such as consumption rooms, outreach services, up-to-date offers for psychosocial and medical care, overnight accommodation and day rooms
- A point of contact for us

### Previous offers of help until now have been absolutely inadequate. The huge police presence in and around Görlitzer Park and Wrangelkiez does not solve the problem. A rethink is necessary!

### We therefore demand:

- More (mobile) consumption rooms with health care services and attached social work for referral to help systems
- Late night opening hours (20:00 03:00)
- Outreach drug services
- A point of contact for residents
- Focused and targeted cooperation strategies between the district and the senate
